


### Western Rail Link to Heathrow

### **Consultation Overview**



- Pre-consultation meetings with local authorities, statutory bodies and community groups
- Consultation Strategy agreed with Local Authorities
- Press adverts in four local papers
- Promotional flyers delivered to 10,500 residents within consultation area
- Website live throughout consultation period where members of the public could leave feedback
- Exhibition preview night for councillors, planning officers, key stakeholders and industry partners
- 15 public exhibition events attended by over 350 people
- Over 950 responses from both public and stakeholders






## How did People Respond?

- 51 email responses






# Support for Network Rail's proposals

81% of people agreed strongly or agreed with Network Rail's plan


Do you agree with Network Rail's plans to improve access to Heathrow Airport from the West?











## Key themes
